CLEP TRANSFER CREDIT GUIDELINES UNDERGRADUATE - BA & BMUS 2021-2022

The College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) offers a series of exams that test a student's knowledge of the materials typically covered in college-level general education courses. The exams are administered by national testing centers, usually located at major colleges or universities. Exam registration and further information can be found on the College Board website clep.collegeboard.org or by calling 1-800-257-9558.

- **Submission Deadline** - All CLEP exam scores must be submitted by August 1, January 1, March 1 for fall, spring and summer graduates respectively. Failure to do so will delay your graduation to the subsequent term.
- It is recommended that CLEP Exams be taken within your first 2 years at MBI.
- **50** - A minimum score of 50 is required to accept credit to satisfy MBI general education requirements. Minimum scores may vary for certain language exams. Please visit clep.collegeboard.org/clep-exams for more details.
- **10** - Academic/test credits that exceed 10 years from the date of completion are not applicable toward current degree curricula.
- **Official scores** - When you register to take CLEP, request an official CLEP transcript to be sent to Moody Bible Institute by indicating the CLEP code for MBI (**1486**).

+ Not required for Biblical Languages, Pastoral, Applied Linguistics, Jewish Studies, or TESOL majors prior to the 21-22 curriculum. Not required for BA students as of the 21-22 curriculum.
