CLEP TRANSFER CREDIT GUIDELINES UNDERGRADUATE-BA & BMUS 2018-2019

The College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) offers a series of exams that test a student’s knowledge of the materials typically covered in college-level general education courses. The exams are administered by national testing centers, usually located at major colleges or universities. Exam registration and further information can be found on the College Board website clep.collegeboard.org or call 1-800-257-9558.

- **Submission Deadline** - All CLEP exam scores must be submitted prior to the start of your final semester at MBI. Failure to do so will delay your graduation to the subsequent term. It is recommended that CLEP Exams be taken within your first 2 years at MBI.
- **50** - A minimum score of 50 is required to accept credit to satisfy MBI general education requirements.
- **10** - Academic/test credits that exceed 10 years from the date of completion are not applicable toward current degree curricula.
- **Official scores** - When you register to take CLEP, request an official CLEP transcript to be sent to Moody Bible Institute by indicating the CLEP code for MBI (**1486**).
- **Study Guides** - Study guides can be ordered from the CLEP website.
