



**Courses being considered for transfer credit must meet the following criteria:**

- **Accredited** – Credit must be earned through a regionally, TRACS, or ABHE accredited college and submitted on an official transcript.
- **College-Level** – Credit must be college-level (usually numbered 100 or higher).
- **“C” or above** – Credit earned within the last **10** years with a grade of **“C”** or above.
  - **Pass/fail** courses and credits earned over 10 years will not transfer.
- **75%** – The combined total of all transfer credits cannot exceed 75% of an MBI program.
- **Equivalent** – Coursework must be equivalent to MBI requirements in content and credit hours.
  - (Example: **4.5** quarter hours = **3** semester hours)

MBI Course:	CR	Transfer Course Examples:
<b>College Writing</b>	3	English Composition I, Freshman Composition I, Freshman English.
<b>Research Writing</b>	3	English Composition II, Freshman Composition II, English and Rhetoric. Must include an 8-10 page research paper.
<b>Speech Communication</b>	3	Public Speaking, Oral or Basic Communication. Must include a public speaking component.
<b>Introduction to Philosophy</b>	3	Principles, Fundamentals, or General Philosophy. Must include an overview of the history of philosophy and cover all of the following philosophical topics: epistemology, metaphysics, axiology, and ethics.
<b>Social Science Elective #</b>	3	Introduction to Psychology, Introduction to Sociology, Human Development, Intercultural Communication, or Marriage and Family Systems.
<b>Literature Elective #</b>	3	American, British, World, Ethnic, or Children’s Literature. Any literature course offered through the English or Literature Departments.
<b>Math/Science Requirement #</b> 5 credits required prior to the 2019-2020 curriculum 3 credits required as of the 2019-2020 curriculum	3-5	Course(s) offered through the Mathematics and/or Natural Science Departments, such as College Algebra, Pre-Calculus, Trigonometry Anatomy, Astronomy, Biology, Botany, Chemistry, Geology, Physics, etc. (Nutrition and Environmental Science courses typically do not transfer.)
<b>Foreign Language +</b>	6	Must be 6 credit hours of the same language. American Sign Language and Phonetics/Linguistics also meet this requirement.
<b>Open Elective #</b> Required as of the 2019-2020 curriculum	3	Any additional course that meets the transfer credit criteria.

# Not required for BA-Music and BMUS majors (5 credits of Math/Science required for BA-Music students prior to 2018).

+ Not required for Biblical Languages, Pastoral, Applied Linguistics, Jewish Studies, or TESOL majors.
