



Courses and tests being considered for transfer credit must meet the following criteria:

- **Submission Deadline** - All transfer credit and exam scores must be submitted prior to the start of your final semester at MBI. Failure to do so will delay your graduation to the subsequent term. It is recommended that CLEP Exams be taken within your first 2 years at MBI.
- **Accredited** – Credit must be earned through a regionally, ABHE, or TRACS accredited college.
- **College-Level** – Credit must be college-level (usually numbered 100 or higher. **Pass/fail** courses will not transfer).
- **“C” or above** – Transfer courses must be graded “C” or above. Test credit must meet the minimum score.

The **Advanced Placement (AP)** is a program in the United States and Canada created by the College Board offering college-level curriculum and examinations to high school students. Questions regarding AP should be directed to the Advanced Placement Program at 609-771-7300 or at www.collegeboard.org/ap/. **A minimum score of 3 is required unless otherwise noted.**

The **College-Level Examination Program (CLEP)** offers a series of exams that test a student’s knowledge of the materials typically covered in college-level general education courses. Exam registration and further information can be found on the College Board website clep.collegeboard.org or by calling 1-800-257-9558. **Official scores** must be sent to Moody Bible Institute by indicating the CLEP code for MBI (1486). **A minimum score of 50 is required.**
