## ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAMS (AP) GUIDELINES 2019-2020

The **Advanced Placement (AP)** is a program in the United States and Canada created by the College Board offering college-level curriculum and examinations to high school students. - **10** - Academic/test credits that exceed 10 years from the date of completion are not applicable toward current degree.
- **25%** - A maximum of 25% of a MDL program can be fulfilled with applicable test credits (AP or CLEP). (Up to **30** credits for BS and up to **15** credits for ABS degrees)
- **Official scores** – request official score report(s) to be sent to Moody Bible Institute Academic Records.
- **3** – a minimum score of 3 is required, unless otherwise noted below.
