

The **College-Level Examination Program (CLEP)** offers a series of exams that test a student’s knowledge of the materials typically covered in college-level general education courses. The exams are administered by national testing centers, usually located at major colleges or universities. Exam registration and further information can be found on the College Board website clep.collegeboard.org or by calling 1-800-257-9558. Official CLEP results may be sent to Moody by indicating the CLEP code for MBI: **1486**.

A **minimum score of 50 required** for transfer to Moody. All other transfer credit requirements and deadlines apply (see Academic Policies and Graduation Requirements in [academic catalog](#)). It is recommended students submit CLEP scores before program is 50% complete. Requirements vary with program.
